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## ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULING ORDER

The Appellant's February 28, 2013, Consent Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order represents that the parties agree that additional time is necessary to resolve a scheduling conflict; to provide the parties with additional time to pursue settlement, and; to provide the District's new primary counsel with adequate time to review the file and complete discovery. We note that the instant appeal was filed on September 29, 2010, and, inconsistent with the Board policy of expeditiously resolving all cases, there have been numerous delays. <u>August 26, 2013</u>	This date shall serve as the last date for either party to file dispositive motions, or; to serve objections to the Appeal File or the Supplement to the Appeal File.
November 19, 2013	Prehearing conference at the Board, beginning at 10:30 a.m.
	Parties shall file a proposed Joint Pretrial Statement with the Board including respective exhibit and witness lists, statement of stipulated facts, and statement of stipulated costs (if any). The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of the exhibits that each party intends to enter into evidence at trial. The parties are not required to provide a hard copy of the entire Appeal File and Appeal File Supplement; only those exhibits that will be entered into evidence at trial.
December 3-5, 2013	Hearing on the merits in the Board courtroom beginning at 10:30 a.m. daily. The District shall provide a court reporter.
