11-15-2012	Expert discovery shall be completed.
12-15-2012	The parties shall submit a joint pretrial statement including respective exhibit and witness lists, and a statement of stipulated facts.
01-15-2013	The parties shall file all dispositive motions no later than this date.
02-19-2013	Prehearing conference at the Board beginning at 10:30 a.m.
03-25-2013	Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m. daily to conclude no later than 03-27-2013. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement in this matter. Early settlement conserves resources and avoids delays. The Board is available to assist with settlement efforts upon request.

All motions requesting an extension of a deadline, or continuance of a hearing or conference, shall be filed in accordance with Board Rule 124. Such motions shall include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.

This Scheduling Order may be amended only by Board order upon motion properly filed and served.
