The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of all exhibits the parties plan to introduce as evidence at the trial hereof. |

| <u>July 15, 2014</u> | Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m. daily to conclude no later than July 17, 2014. The District shall provide a court reporter. |
