AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

On May 19, 2014, the Appellant filed a Consent Motion to Extend Trial Date. The motion shows good cause, as the previously scheduled trial date conflicts with Appellant counsel's U.S. Air Force Reserve obligation. Accordingly, the motion is granted. Pursuant to Board Rules of Procedure 101.4, the Board issues the following Amended Scheduling Order herein:

<u>August 15, 2014</u>	Appellant shall designate its expert and file its expert report.
<u>September 15, 2014</u>	The District shall designate its expert and file its expert report.
<u>September 30, 2014</u>	Discovery requests shall be completed.
<u>October 15, 2014</u>	Witness lists shall be exchanged.
<u>October 30, 2014</u>	Discovery shall be closed.
<u>November 3, 2014</u>	The parties shall file all dispositive motions no later than this date.
<u>November 17, 2014</u>	Parties shall file a proposed Joint Pretrial Statement with the Board including respective exhibit and final witness lists, statement of stipulated facts, and statement of stipulated costs (if any). The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of all exhibits the parties plan to introduce as evidence at the trial hereof.
<u>December 11, 2014</u>	Prehearing conference at the Board beginning at 1:00 p.m.
<u>January 13, 2015</u>	Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m. daily to conclude no later

than January 15, 2015. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement in this matter. Early settlement conserves resources and avoids delays. The Board is available to assist with settlement efforts upon request.

All motions requesting an extension of a deadline, or continuance of a hearing or conference, shall be filed in accordance with D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27, §124. Such motions shall include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.

This Scheduling Order amends the previous Board Order dated April 14, 2014. The instant Order may be amended only by Board order upon motion properly filed and served.
