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REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER

On December 12, 2013, the parties filed a consent motion to extend the Board's Scheduling Order dated November 29, 2013. Good cause having been shown, the motion is granted. Accordingly, the schedule herein is revised as follows:

<u>January 31, 2014</u>	The District shall file its Answer and the Appeal File.
<u>January 31, 2014</u>	All discovery shall be complete by this date.
<u>February 10, 2014</u>	The Appellant shall file the Appeal File Supplement.
<u>January 31, 2014</u>	The parties shall file all dispositive motions by this date.
<u>March 3, 2014</u>	Prehearing conference at the Board, beginning at 1:00 p.m. Parties shall file a proposed Joint Pretrial Statement with the Board including respective exhibit and final witness lists, statement of stipulated facts, and statement of stipulated costs (if any). The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of all exhibits the parties plan to introduce as evidence at the trial.
<u>April 10, 2014</u>	Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m. daily and shall conclude no later than April 15, 2014. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

This scheduling order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
