The Board's December 21, 2012, Acknowledgment states that:

It is the policy of the Board that a scheduling order will be issued within 45 days of the case filing date. Thus, the parties shall submit a joint proposed scheduling order within 45 days of the case filing date. If the parties fail to agree upon a proposed scheduling order, the Board will convene a scheduling conference.

As the parties have failed to submit a joint proposed scheduling order, they shall attend a Scheduling Conference in the Board courtroom at 2:00 p.m. on April 8, 2013. Additionally, the parties shall submit a joint proposed scheduling order to the Board's General Counsel via email by March 26, 2013, the adoption of which by the Board may result in cancellation of the Scheduling Conference.

The Board is mindful that appellee's motion to dismiss is pending. The Board's requirement for submission of a joint proposed scheduling order is designed to prevent delays in the disposition of cases. The Board's requirement for submission of a joint proposed scheduling order operates independently of whether dispositive motions are pending with the Board.
