CONSOLIDATION AND SCHEDULING ORDER

On June 5, 2014, Ciber, Inc. filed a Consent Motion to Consolidate CAB No. D-1496 with previously consolidated Ciber appeal Nos. D-1471, D-1472, D-1485 and D-1486. The motion shows good cause, as D-1496 and the previously consolidated Ciber appeals involve the same parties, the same contract, potentially the same witnesses, and common issues of law and fact. Pursuant to Board Rule 118, the Board consolidates the appeal proceedings of CAB Nos. D-1496, D-1471, D-1472, D-1485 and D-1486.

Accordingly, the Board issues the following Scheduling Order for the consolidated appeals herein:

- October 17, 2014: All written discovery requests shall be made by this date.
- November 21, 2014: Appellant's expert report(s) shall be disclosed by this date.
- December 22, 2014: The District's expert report(s) shall be disclosed by this date.
- January 23, 2015: All discovery shall be completed by this date.
- February 23, 2015: The parties shall file all dispositive motions by this date.
- March 30, 2015: The parties shall submit a Joint Pretrial Statement including respective exhibit and witness lists, and a statement of stipulated facts. The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of the Appeal File, Appeal File Supplement exhibits and each party's hearing exhibits. The parties shall also provide a CD containing all hearing exhibits.
- April 14, 2015: Prehearing conference at the Board at 1:30 p.m.

May 5, 2015: Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m., daily to conclude no later than May 12, 2015. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement in this matter. Early settlement conserves resources and avoids delays. The Board is available to assist with settlement efforts upon request.

All motions requesting an extension of a deadline, or continuance of a hearing or conference, shall be filed in accordance with Board Rule 124. Such motions shall include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.

This Scheduling Order may be amended only by Board order upon motion properly filed and served.
