CONSOLIDATION AND SCHEDULING ORDER

The facts and issues in D-1286, D-1297 and D-1389 are highly related and involve the same contract. Accordingly, we consolidate the appeals for further proceedings.

Pursuant to Board Rules of Procedure 101.4, the Board issues the following Scheduling Order herein:

<u>August 9, 2011</u>	The District shall file its answer to the complaint in D-1297.
<u>October 26, 2011</u>	The parties shall make their respective discovery requests no later than this date.
<u>January 13, 2012</u>	All non-expert discovery shall be completed by this date.
<u>March 23, 2012</u>	Appellant's expert designation and report shall be disclosed.
<u>April 13, 2012</u>	District's expert designation and report shall be disclosed.
<u>May 16, 2012</u>	Expert witness discovery shall be completed by this date.
<u>June 15, 2012</u>	All dispositive motions shall be filed by this date.
<u>July 20, 2012</u>	The parties shall submit a proposed joint pretrial statement, including respective exhibit and witness lists. Only witnesses identified by this date may testify at the hearing.
<u>October 16, 2012</u>	Prehearing conference at the Board at 11:00 a.m. All objections to fact witnesses and exhibits shall be resolved.
<u>November 5, 2012</u>	Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:00 a.m. daily to conclude no later than November 9, 2012. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement in this matter. Early settlement conserves resources and avoids delays. The Board is available to assist with settlement efforts upon request.

All motions requesting an extension of a deadline, or continuance of a hearing or conference, shall be filed in accordance with Board Rule 124. Such motions shall include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.

This Scheduling Order may be amended only by Board order upon motion properly filed and served.
