**ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULE AND GRANTING MOTION TO ENLARGE**

On April 10, 2013, the parties appeared before the Board for a Prehearing Conference herein. The appellant was represented by Kenneth S. Nankin, Esq. The appellee was represented by Matthew G. Lane, Esq. and Carlos M. Sandoval, Esq. The Prehearing Conference was deferred, as the Board granted the Appellee’s Motion to Enlarge Deadlines.

Accordingly, pursuant to D.C. Mun. Regs. tit. 27, § 101.4, the Board issues the following amended Scheduling Order herein:

- September 13, 2013                      The Appellee shall file its Prehearing Statement including exhibit and witness lists, statement of stipulated facts, and statement of stipulated costs (if any).
  
- September 26, 2013                      Prehearing Conference at the Board, beginning at 1:00 p.m. The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of the the parties’ trial exhibits (unless already provided). The parties are not required to provide a hard copy of the entire Appeal File and Appeal File Supplement; only those exhibits that will be entered into evidence at trial.
  
- October 23, 2013                      Hearing on the merits in the Board courtroom beginning at 10:30 a.m., and continuing until October 25, 2013. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

The Board admonished the District that it does not intend to further extend the hearing date beyond October 25, 2013, and that discovery will not be reopened for any purpose. Because this case was filed in 2007, and the Board is prioritizing the disposition of aged cases on our docket, we strongly encourage the District to ensure that at least one of its attorneys is

prepared to commence trial as scheduled herein. The Board appreciates the professionalism that counsel for both parties have shown in completing the discovery and other pretrial phases of this case.

This scheduling order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
