**ORDER GRANTING CONSENT MOTION
TO ENLARGE SCHEDULING ORDER DEADLINES**

On January 19, 2016, Appellant filed a consent motion to enlarge the non-expert discovery deadline set forth in the Board’s December 9, 2015, Scheduling Order.¹ (*See* Consent Mot. to Enlarge Scheduling Order Deadlines.) Appellant represents that an extension is necessary to conduct depositions of certain previously-unavailable witnesses. (*Id.* at 2.) Upon review of the entire record herein, there being no opposition to the above, and good cause having been shown to amend the current schedule, the Board hereby grants Appellant’s motion, and amends the schedule as follows—

- February 11, 2016: All non-expert discovery shall be completed by this date.
- February 16, 2016: The parties shall file a proposed Joint Pretrial Statement with the Board, including respective exhibit and final witness lists, and a statement of stipulated facts, by close-of-business on this date. The parties shall provide the Board with a single CD and a tabbed, indexed single courtesy copy (3 ring binder) of all exhibits the parties plan to introduce as evidence at the trial hereof.
- February 19, 2016: Prehearing conference in the Board courtroom, beginning at 11:00 a.m.
- March 8-11, 2016: Rule 119 hearing as to entitlement only, beginning at 10:30 a.m. March 8-9 and 11, and at 1:00 p.m. on March 10, 2016. The Rule 119 hearing shall conclude no later than March 11, 2016. The District shall provide a court reporter.

¹ Pursuant to the Board’s Dec. 9, 2015, Order, the deadline for all non-expert discovery is currently set for February 1, 2016. (*See* Order Granting Mot. to Withdraw and Amending Schedule at 1.)

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

This scheduling order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
