Pursuant to Board Rules of Procedure 101.4, the Board issues the following Scheduling Order herein:

| <u>December 3, 2012:</u> | All written discovery requests shall be made by this date. |
| <u>May 10, 2013:</u> | Appellant's expert report shall be disclosed. |
| <u>June 14, 2013:</u> | District's expert report shall be disclosed. |
| <u>August 2, 2013:</u> | All discovery shall be completed by this date. |
| <u>August 15, 2013:</u> | The parties shall make all objections to the Appeal File. |
| <u>August 29, 2013:</u> | The parties shall file all dispositive motions by this date. |
| <u>October 8, 2013:</u> | Parties shall file a Joint Pretrial Statement with the Board, which should include: (a) a statement of the case for each party, including the factual basis for all amounts being claimed by either party; (b) a statement of the legal issues involved in each party's case; (c) the claims and defenses of each party; (d) stipulations of fact; (e) stipulations as to the admissibility of certain exhibits; (f) the parties' respective hearing witness lists, with each witness listed in the order of examination, and which shall include a proffer of testimony for each witness to be provided at the hearing and the anticipated duration of their examination; and (g) the parties' respective exhibit lists, which shall identify the witness through which each exhibit will be introduced. |
| <u>October 15, 2013:</u> | Prehearing conference at the Board, beginning at 11 a.m. |
| <u>November 12, 2013:</u> | Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:00 a.m. daily to conclude no later than November 15, 2013. The District shall provide a court reporter. |

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

This scheduling order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
