SCHEDULING ORDER

The Board held a telephone status conference in the above-captioned appeal on May 25, 2016. Participating for the Appellant were Oliver Garcia, Esq., Allison Van Horn, Esq., and Michael K. Ross, Esq. Participating for Appellee, the District of Columbia, was Matthew G. Lane, Esq. During the teleconference, the parties provided the Board with an update concerning the status of the instant matter, and the prospects for settlement. While Appellee's counsel is continuing to review the prospects for reaching a global settlement that may include D-1461 and D-1097, the parties do not indicate that settlement discussions have produced an agreement as of yet. Thus, the Board directs that our April 14, 2016, Stay Order is hereby rescinded, and the following Scheduling Order take effect immediately:

- September 9, 2016: The parties shall submit a Joint Pretrial Statement, including respective exhibit and witness lists, and a statement of stipulated facts. The Board shall be given a tabbed, indexed, single courtesy copy (three-ring binder) of the Appeal File, Appeal File Supplement(s), and each party's hearing exhibits, along with a CD containing the same.
- October 3, 2016: Prehearing conference at the Board beginning at 1:00 p.m.
- October 5-6, 2016: Hearing on the merits of the claims in the Board courtroom at 10:30 a.m. daily, to conclude no later than October 6, 2016. The District shall provide a court reporter.

The parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

This order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
