Hearing on the merits in the Board courtroom beginning at 10:30 a.m. daily, and continuing through August 1, 2014. The District shall provide a court reporter.

Further, upon review of appellee's January 22, 2013, Motion to Dismiss, the opposition thereto, and the entire record herein, appellee's motion is denied. The Board has jurisdiction over the contracting officer's denial of appellant's claim to convert the default termination herein to one for convenience. The parties are instructed to meet and confer regarding the status of overlapping discovery requests between the instant case and CAB No. D-1358.

Additionally, the parties are encouraged to pursue settlement throughout these proceedings. Settlement conserves resources and, where pursued early, may prevent delays. The Board is available to assist the parties with settlement discussions upon request.

This scheduling order may be amended only by leave of the Board upon motion properly filed and served. All motions shall be in writing, and filed in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure, and such motions shall also include proposed dates that are mutually agreeable to all counsel and/or unrepresented parties.
